INTRODUCTION TO THE PRIMARY LOGO

In 2024, the 8th East Asian Seas (EAS) Congress will be held in Xiamen City, People's Republic of China on 6-8 November 2024, in collaboration with the Xiamen World Ocean Week (XWOW).

The EAS Congress 2024 logo serves as the corporate identity of this triennial event, which will be used in all promotional materials. This branding guideline includes information about the logo, proper use in designs and different media, and appropriate attribution.

LOGO VARIATIONS

HORIZONTAL

The horizontal version is the primary logo format to be used in all collaterals.

DON'TS

PLACEMENT & POSITION

DO NOT: change the placement of the logotype and logo as presented in the logo variation







COLORS

DO NOT: change the color of the elements as presented in the logo variation







RESIZING

DO NOT: Do not squish or squash the logo. Any resizing must be in proportion to how it was presented.







FORMAT

DO NOT: reformat the logo. The only variation that can be used is horizontal and vertical format (see logo variation) upright position









PRIMARY AND SECONDARY COLORS

The primary colors will be applied as the dominant colour palette in all collaterals including but not limited to social media posts, website, and print materials.

TYPEFACE

PRIMARY

Bebas Neue should be used as the main typeface for headers where the brand is implemented. This is also used as the primary typeface in the EAS Congress logo set.

Avenir Next LT Pro or **Avenir** should be used as standard body text in all materials of the EAS Congress 2024: website, brochures, posters, and all forms of correspondences.

This is also the typeface used in EAS Congress 2024 theme.

SECONDARY

Arial should be used in all meeting documents and other Congress-related presentations that is not part of materials published on public domains.




PUBLICATION LAYOUT AND FORMAT



The use of EAS Congress logo set by partners in any publication should be done with the approval of PEMSEA Resource Facility.








SAMPLE BACKGROUND DESIGN


